2-1-1 Get Connected

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Did you know that by simply dialing the numbers 2-1-1 that you have access to hundreds of health and human services available to you right here in Moore County? Yes, 2-1-1 is a 3-digit number that connects you to basic needs, consumer services, education, health care, income support, mental health care, government services and more in our community. In 2014, 559 calls to 2-1-1 resulted in 557 referrals for services, information or advocacy in Moore County.

2-1-1 is a public service of United Way of Moore County. It's different from 9-1-1 in that 2-1-1 is not for emergencies. 2-1-1 helps people find health and human services to meet their everyday needs. It's free, confidential, and multi-lingual. Just dial 2-1-1.

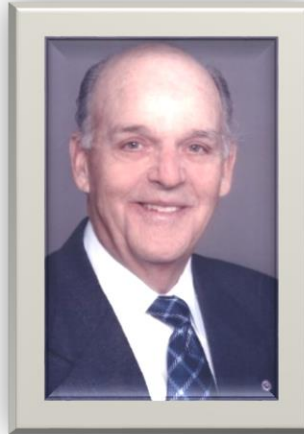
United Way Partner Spotlight:
